Disney Trip FAQ's

What will the students be doing?

The students will be able to explore one of Disney's theme parks per day. They will attend a behind the scenes music workshop in which they sight read and rehearse music from a Disney animated film, culminating in an experience scoring a scene from the film itself in a recording studio. They will also march pre-parade at the Magic Kingdom.

How much does it cost, and do we have to pay for it all at once?

Student price is \$978 based on quad hotel room occupancy. Chaperones price is \$1148 based on double occupancy. After the initial \$100 payment, there is a payment schedule of \$175 every other month starting in April and ending in December. Note that the final payment in December is the remaining balance of \$178 for students and \$348 for chaperones.

Will there be fundraising?

We are encouraging each student to treat fundraising as their own personal project, such as bottle drives. Students can also contact Royal Oak Youth Assistance or the Optimists Club for information.

Your Brightspark account also has a "Help Me Travel" link where family and friends can directly contribute to your balance.

How are they traveling?

Students and chaperones will be traveling by deluxe motor coach overnight to Orlando.

My student is not in marching band. How will they participate in the parade?

Students who don't play a marching band instrument will join either the color guard or percussion section. If they do play, they can join their respective instrument section. There will be mandatory marching band rehearsals leading up to the trip. All students will be fitted for an issued marching band uniforms for this trip.

Will the bus be stopping for meals?

Yes. Stops will be determined on the way. Travelers should plan on bringing a bag lunch for the first leg of the departure.

How much luggage can they take?

One medium suitcase per person plus a carry on so that they can freshen up Tuesday morning. Bus cargo storage will have instruments and flags, so room for luggage is at a premium. We trust their judgement in packing for a week. Students are urged to pack lightly. There is no need for lots of extra stuff.

Are all meals included?

At this point, vouchers will be provided for 3 breakfasts and 4 dinners. Resort menus and prices can be found at https://disneyworld.disney.go.com/dining/

Should my student take credit/debit cards?

Credit/debit cards are at each family's discretion. Disney gift cards are accepted everywhere in Disney World.

What happens if I don't sign up by March 15?

The overall structure of the trip, such as cost, number of meals, etc., is based on the number of registrants as of this date. These elements will change if a working number isn't met and could mean less meals or higher cost.

Furthermore, your initial payment will increase to include however many scheduled payments were missed.
