**1. OPEN SPACE, SPORTS AND RECREATION FACILITIES**

The Open Space Group with the help of One Ltd has prepared a “Master plan” to develop the playing field to make it somewhere that people of all ages will want to use. Look at the exciting plans, talk to the team, and make sure you share your comments by completing the OPEN SPACE SURVEY before you leave. What you say counts – these facilities are for the benefit of everyone....

Q. How much money is there for the Open Space Sports and Recreation Facilities?

Money is allocated in unilateral agreements made between the developers and Wychavon. There is currently **£62,033.79 available** to be spent on Open Space and play facilities.

*Other money will become available as other developments are completed. There will be a further **£264,257** that will become available as other major developments currently with planning permission are completed*

**2. THE VILLAGE HALL**

The unilateral agreements made between the developers and Wychavon make no provision for money to be spent on the village hall. Other sources of funding need to be used to restore and improve this important community asset.

As people move into new houses **NEW HOMES BONUS money** is made available by Wychavon to be spent on Community Projects. The amount of New Homes Bonus money currently available to us is **£64,502**

The Parish Council would like this money to be spent to restore and develop our Village Hall.

Talk to the Village Hall Committee representatives and tell them what activities and events you would like to see happening in your hall.
