In the game Monopoly, it is famous for its "GO TO JAIL" card. On the card it states..."do not pass GO, do not collect \$200.00" In life from time to time you feel jailed so to speak. You feel you should be further along than you currently are. You feel as though you are not making any progress. Like the Monopoly card states you are missing your reward due to being jailed in a childish way of living. Your progress is not dependent on your past failures or the things you didn't receive as a child; your progress is dependent on your cooperation with God and His Holy Spirit!

SYSTEMS UNDER TEST or S.U.T

In the above scripture God inspired Paul to write about his childish ways. Paul specifically stated his speech, his understanding and his thinking were impacted by his childish ways. Paul was explaining the process he went through in maturing. He explains that his way of speaking, understanding

and thinking or his S.U.T had to grow. There is nothing wrong with being childish when you are actually a child but when you become an adult those things are no longer accepted. Many Christians have stunted spiritual growth. On the outside they seem to be more mature. These "mature" Christians have been a part of the body of Christ for years but on the inside concerning their hearts they suffer from Immature Inner Life Syndrome. They have not done the things that God has asked them to in order to continue to mature and grow spiritually. (See 1st Corinthians 3:2 and Hebrews 5:12-14) Year by year you should become a little better, a little more like Christ. You should become too big for your old system. Your system should continue to change as you grow. What used to anger you should no longer make you angry. What use to cause you financial hardships should no longer cause you financial hardship; what you use to have a taste for, a hunger for; you should no longer crave. God has called you to make an impact on the world. You may be asking "How can I do that?" Start by being a Christian. Being a Christian is a lifestyle. It begins by believing Jesus Christ lived and died for your sins. Once you believe and confess that Jesus paid the penalty for sin then you allow Him to Lord over your life. Once you confess and decide you no longer want to live life without God, He seals you with His Holy Spirit.
