First Lesson Jeremiah 1:4-12 4 Now the word of the LORD came to me, saying, 5 "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations."

6 Then I said, "Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, I do not know how to speak, for I am only a youth." But the LORD said to me, "Do not say, 'I am only a youth'; for to all to whom I send you, you shall go, and whatever I command you, you shall speak. Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you to deliver you, declares the LORD. Then the LORD put out his hand and touched my mouth. And the LORD said to me, "Behold, I have put my words in your mouth. O See, I have set you this day over nations and over kingdoms, to pluck up and to break down, to destroy and to overthrow, to build and to plant. Then the word of the LORD came to me, saying, "Jeremiah, what do you see?" And I said, "I see an almond branch. Then the LORD said to me, "You have seen well, for I am watching over my word to perform it."

Second Lesson Galatians 6:11-18 11 See with what large letters I am writing to you with my own hand. 12 It is those who want to make a good showing in the flesh who would force you to be circumcised, and only in order that they may not be persecuted for the cross of Christ. 13 For even those who are circumcised do not themselves keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may boast in your flesh. 14 But far be it from me to boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. 15 For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation. 16 And as for all who walk by this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the Israel of God. 17 From now on let no one cause me trouble, for I bear on my body the marks of Jesus. 18 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brothers. Amen.

<u>Gospel</u> Luke 9:57-62 <u>57</u> As they were going along the road, someone said to him, "I will follow you wherever you go."<u>58</u> And Jesus said to him, "Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head."<u>59</u> To another he said, "Follow me." But he said, "Lord, let me first go and bury my father."<u>60</u> And Jesus said to him, "Leave the dead to bury their own dead. But as for you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God."<u>61</u> Yet another said, "I will follow you, Lord, but let me first say farewell to those at my home."<u>62</u> Jesus said to him, "No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God."
