






# Everyone has a story to tell. It's time to tell yours!

The video was shown at a worldwide conference as a way to communicate how this state-of-the-art system can save lives.



A Sales Representative for a local Liberty Mutual Insurance office in Bethel, CT needed a way to communicate a new cost-saving partnership to parents of students enrolled with All-Star Driver driving school.

We worked closely with this client to finesse the message and fine-tune a script. The end product was a 90-second video that gave the sales representative a venue to speak directly to parents. And we worked in stills and video overlay to enhance the message. The video was well received by the driving school, and Liberty Mutual's corporate management.
