

# Official Meeting Minutes from December 9th, 2018 meeting Accepted at the January 6, 2019 Meeting

Steve Forrest called the December 9th meeting at the Belmont Fire Station to order at 8:36

- Treasurer's Report- Current balance \$24,820.95, in addition to \$10,000 in savings. Just received \$10,000 from VAST for the new Tucker. There was a motion to accept the Treasurer's report by Curt Marcheux and seconded by Steve Forrest. It was voted on unanimously to accept.
- **Secretary's Report-**The November 4th meeting minutes were motioned to be accepted as read, by Steve Howlett and seconded by Curt Marcheux. It was voted on unanimously to accept.

### Trails

- Trails still closed. Lots of trees down, lots of work to be done. Garrity's are doing Healdville trail.
- In-town trails tight but new Tucker should fit. Curt said Ludlow is awful as well.
- Huk's property bridge is not looking good.

## **President's Report**

- Need to get land permission forms. Could lead to potential trail closures if forms are not up to date. Club's responsibility to look for land changes. Much easier in person to discuss
- Need to look at boundaries. Need permission slips every year or open-ended
