
Giving at Dawson Covenant Church

The graph below is a comparison of receipts for the first months of the year in 2017 compared to 2018. This graph is provided as a visual reference so that the congregation can see the income that is received each month and how reduced giving might affect our budget. Our mortgage payment due each month is approximately \$4,000. In addition, there are many months that we have been able to pay down an additional \$10,000 in principal.
