# The Stickman No. 9 Puzzle Box 

(Snowflake)

Snowflake puzzles were designed from Robert's quest to produce a simple yet elegant mechanical puzzle that was also a Christmas tree ornament. Most of these went out as presents for friends and family with a few listed for sale. Although simpler and smaller than most Stickman creations, these boxes are only held together by the shapes of their moving parts. They are two puzzles in one and, once solved, come apart into 6 pieces.

First edition puzzles were fashioned out of holly for its ability to withstand the intricate cuts of a special router bit Robert developed to produce them. These puzzles used only wax as a finish to preserve their

pure white color.
 Second editions were called the "Snowball", and were made larger and from walnut to preserve the uniqueness and value of the originals. These are one of Robert's favorite designs due to their elegant simplicity, and come closest to his criteria of a perfect box.
