MN1312CN - RM 1.3 - New U of MN release. Excellent yield potential for an early variety. Yellow hilum, good protein and oil content. Soybean Cyst Nematode resistant. Phytophthora root rot resistant, tolerant to iron chlorosis. Good lodging.

MN1701CN - RM 1.7 - Outstanding yield performance for maturity, excellent SCN resistance. Med-tall height. Good protein and oil, yellow hilum. Iron chlorosis tolerant. U of MN release.

IAR1902SCN - RM 1.9 - Excellent yielding full season soybean. New 'Peking' source of SCN resistance, more effective than the standard PI 88788 source that SCN populations have become tolerant to. Buff Hilum. Moderate brown stem rot resistance. Med-tall, good standing. High protein and oil. U of IA release.
