Today, we return to Ordinary Time in the Church Year. After the seasons of Advent/Christmas and Lent/Easter, the church year enters into Ordinary Time until Advent later this year. Although this time is called “ordinary” in the liturgical calendar, it is not meant to be commonplace or usual or average. Ordinary in this sense means “ordered” or “counted.” Thus, each week between now and the start of Advent is sequentially numbered. Today, we begin with the Tenth Sunday of Ordinary time and our weekends will be numbered from now until the thirty-third Sunday in November.

Between now and then our weekly scripture selections will be ripe with imagery and various parables and lessons. Today, we hear a gospel passage about choices. Jesus is tested to make a choice between good and bad. We face this choice daily in our lives when it comes to family, work, faith and Church. Hopefully, we will continue to make the right choice and in doing so, faithfully live the Gospel message in our daily lives.

With the beginning of the summer season, many of us will take a break from the regular routine and enjoy the outdoors, travel and get caught up on some much needed rest and relaxation. I hope this is a refreshing time for you and your family. In a very real sense, summer is certainly not “ordinary” and neither is this season in the Church! Let us keep this in mind as we enter into the summer and this new season of the Church Year.
