

Inland West Mission Center Virtual Worship Technology Grant

The Inland West Mission Center Virtual Worship Technology Grant (TG) is available to the congregations of the Inland West Mission center who desire to expand ministries that occur on line through streaming platforms or who wish to begin offering online ministries and need a small financial boost. These grants may be used to purchase hardware and software for congregational use in offering ministry. These moneys may not be used to improve audio or visual equipment that is only accessed through attendance at a church building or meeting place. These grants are also not meant to offset platform subscription fees. These grants are meant to bring face to face ministry to people who are unable to attend corporate worship.

Applying Congregations must provide a clear plan, as specific as possible, for ministry implementation. The plan must include a name and contact for the person who will be managing the ministry as well as the names of others on the ministry team. The plan must also include projected costs and a time line for implementation.

These grants are funded by a member of the Inland West Mission Center who was touched by participating in an online worship experience during the Covid-19 pandemic. Her generosity, in conjunction with mission center support is providing four (4), two hundred fifty dollar (\$250.00) grants.

The funds will be granted upon completion, approval of and receipt of documentation (sales receipts) of expenditures on the technology purchases. To receive the full \$250.00 a congregation must spend at least \$500.00 on equipment or software. If the purchases are less than \$500.00 then the mission center will reimburse the congregation for half of the total expenditures. No grants will exceed \$250.00
