

Our new year of 2023-2024 started July 1, 2023 and ends June 30, 2024. As of this writing, we are at 741 paid members = 101.65%. The 2022-2023 year ended with 729 paid members.

There are still some members who have not paid their 2024 dues. Get those dues paid. If you lapse your membership and you still want to be a member, you will have to complete another application and have all the paperwork of the veteran you are coming in attached. Please do not let that happen.

All 2024 dues renewal were sent out in July and August 2023. Current dues for a continuous member is \$25. (FYI...National has raised the dues effective 7/1/2024. Highly recommend that you convert to a lifetime membership. This way you will not have to pay anything else for membership).

THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT.-Are you a Post Member? Is your spouse, father, mother, son, daughter, brother, sister or grandchildren members of the auxiliary?? I know I sound like a broken record. BUT-THEY SHOULD BE! YOU, the Post Member, ARE the Qualifying Veteran. Please get them an application (one included in the G2) and turn it in. If they are not an auxiliary member, you should be asking yourself, "Why Aren't They"?. What if something should happen to you? They would have to submit all the qualifying paperwork of the veteran. Also..they would not have privileges to the clubroom While you are a current member, all we need is the Post Members Membership #. Really think about it. There are no exceptions.
