Secret Sisters

Are you interested in joining Secret Sisters? It is so much fun!

Here are the details in a nut shell. Each Secret Sister will complete a questionnaire about herself (available on the MFF website and via email). The deadline to submit your **completed questionnaire** is **Friday, September 20th**. After we receive them, we will match everyone up with a Secret Sister. That person may use the information provided in your questionnaire to pick out a special gift for you each month! We will get together three times throughout the club year for gift exchange potlucks (see the Evites for more info). In May we will reveal who each person's Secret Sister has been. And then in June, you will give a "thank you" gift to the not-so-secret-anymore Sister who had been giving gifts to YOU for the previous eight months!

The gift exchanges will occur anonymously every month from October through May, and every participant should give AND receive a gift each month. You can ask another member to help make your delivery, or watch Evite and bring it to an event that you know she will be attending... you have plenty of sneaky options. But try your best to keep yourself a secret - that's what makes this so much fun! The value should be kept around \$15 for your monthly gift. And we also ask that no one "double dip" and buy one large, more expensive gift to count for multiple months.

We ask that once you join us, you understand that a very special woman (your Secret Sister) is counting on your full participation. There is no fee to join Secret Sisters.
