

MORNING COFFEE

Enter Havurat in the morning and you will be greeted by the aroma of freshly brewed coffee and a lively debate over some fine point of logic in the Talmud. For almost twenty years the morning Gemara Shiur has attracted people of various backgrounds and knowledge levels to delve into the Talmudic text. The coffee aroma is a symbol of our camaraderie and commitment. Some started coming to the class only to drink a cup of coffee and still others just came to prepare the coffee, and even today that cup of coffee represents the kindness that is a preeminent trait of Havurat.

Doctors, businessmen, students, retirees and the occasional participant meet over a page of the preeminent repository of our tradition and wisdom, and no one has left untouched by the profundity of thought and the spiritual inspiration. Talmud has been compared to the ocean, so vast and deep are its ideas and lessons. Now, as we are about halfway through the texts, we can look back and realize what a major achievement it has been!

Tonight, as we honor this group, we have not forgotten the many participants who are not in our community now but who have carried the inspiration of this class with them to various locales. The current members, Solly Benroubi, David Sosnowik and Mark Silverman, meet with me in the days of blistering cold or suffocating heat with the same devotion regardless of what goes on outside. This is an apt metaphor for how we depart

temporarily from our physical locations and we immerse in the Talmudic discussions as if we were in some Babylonian academy. We talk with the rabbis. Rav Yochanan, Resh Lakish, Rava, Abaye, and Rashi are there to help us navigate the intricate discussion. We speak of them as if they were here, next to us, in the present. After this journey in time, we get back to the 21st century and reflect on the lessons we have learned from the past and how we continue to apply the wisdom of our Rabbis to our contemporary issues both national and personal.

I am sure that this class has added much to Havurat and to our general community. The love of Torah, the dedication of the students, the ethical lessons, new intellectual concepts and profound psychological insights we have learned have changed our lives and also the lives of those who for even a moment overhear a discussion in a point of Torah.

It is with great joy that I salute the current participants and all who have ever attended this class. Ours and yours is the greatest blessing, the merit of laboring over the study of our sacred Torah and its beloved teachers.

Mazal tov, and let us ever increase our love of learning and our reverence for the wisdom of our great teachers.

Rabbi David Algaze

Our beloved Mara d'Atra, Rabbi Algaze, is well known to all of us for his warmth, sincerity and great ahavat Israel. Together with his Rebbetzen, Tamara, they form an extraordinary team of ingenuity, dedication and charm.

Our Rabbi, born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, has lived most of his life in the United States and yet he has kept his Latin American flavor and love of life. A graduate of the University of Buenos Aires and Columbia University in New York, Rabbi Algaze is an academician and scholar in the fields of Greek and Latin literature as well as fluent in many languages. He has taught at several institutions of higher learning and written for several publications in different languages, most recently as a weekly columnist for The Jewish Press. He received his semikha from Rabbi Messas in Haifa and from Rabbi Basry of the Jerusalem High Court and he considers himself a disciple of the revered Rosh Yeshiva of Hafetz Hayim, Rav Leibowitz, zt'l. His passion for music, art and sports have made him a worldly leader with broad insight and interests. However, his greatest passion is the defense of Eretz Israel to which he has dedicated many hours of his time in activities, rallies and advocacy. He is the founder of the Coalition for Israel and is currently the President of the World Committee for the Land of Israel.



Salomon (Solly) Benroubi

I fit the model of the Wandering Jew. I was born in Egypt and used to speak with a French accent. Then I moved to Brazil and spoke Portuguese with an Egyptian accent. Then I moved to the US, and I admit that I have a Brazilian accent. But Boruch HaShem, I was able to see the hashgacha all the way, and I am happy, and hope that Havurat Yisrael has become my last stop before the geulah.

When I left Brazil, I was planning to move to Canada, and we just stopped in New York for a few weeks to visit our family and spend some time with them. But we were advised to stay here in New York, since there are more opportunities than in Canada. I am not sure whether New York has more or less work opportunities than Vancouver. But I am quite sure that we found, after many years of searching, a place to belong and discover our Jewish roots. New York has so many different Jewish institutions, shuls, yeshivot, etc. But when we look back, we see the guiding hand of Hashem bringing us precisely to Havurat Yisrael, reconnecting to the Algaze Dynasty and finding so many things in common. Both my mother and Rabbi Algaze's mother had the same name, they were both from Syria, they both came to Egypt, and they both married men who spoke Spanish or Ladino. All this, even though we live in such a diverse melting pot.

I would like to thank the Rabbi who fulfilled the pasuk "Hazorim bedina, berina yiktzoru," by planting the seeds of Havurat and helping us to arrive at this night after 35 years! May we be zoche to see the fulfillment of the words of our Sages, that in the future our shuls will be transported to Eretz Yisrael with the coming of Moshiach Tzidkenu.



Mark Silverman

Mark Silverman was born in Brooklyn to parents Benjamin and Roslyn. He grew up in Forest Hills, where he attended Forest Hills High School and the Forest Hills Jewish Center. He graduated *cum laude* from Syracuse University in 1979, where he was a member of the Syracuse University Voluntary Ambulance Corp. and president of Alpha Epsilon Delta Premedical Honor Society. His summers were spent performing research for the Division of Infectious Diseases at the Cornell University Medical Center and for the Department of Medical Oncology at the Mount Sinai School of Medicine. He received his MD degree from the State University of New York at Downstate Medical Center in Brooklyn in 1983. After completing an internal medicine residency at the Long Island Jewish Medical Center, he continued his training there as both a clinical and research fellow in gastroenterology. His work has been published in leading medical journals and has been presented at scientific meetings in Dallas and Chicago.

After completing his training in 1988 he, along with Dr. David Sosnowik, started Austin Medical Associates in Forest Hills, where they continue to serve the Forest Hills community in the practice of internal medicine and gastroenterology.

Mark and his wife Gail, with their children Ilyse and Holden, live in Roslyn, Long Island. Besides enjoying family vacations, Mark's hobbies include skiing, golf, building model railroads, and flying radio-controlled model airplanes. He enthusiastically pursues oil painting, but most importantly, he gets his regular fill of weekly Talmud classes from Rabbi Algaze.



David Sosnowik

David has much "hakarat hatov" for Havurat Yisrael. While it may have started with involvement in the Havurat Ski Shabbaton, later the summer camp, and slowly becoming a regular in the morning minyan, David's connection to Havurat was cemented by meeting his wife Debbie at a Singles Shabbaton in the shul. They were married by Rabbi Algaze, surrounded by their friends from Havurat. What attracted them to our community in the first place is that it doesn't really matter where you come from or what you do (hence no need for an extensive bio).

Originally from the Silver Spring, MD/Washington DC area, David moved to New York for postgraduate medical training, where he met and trained with Mark Silverman, and in 1988 they founded Austin Medical Associates in Forest Hills (the "other marriage" for both).

The ability to share the warmth, learning, and uplifting spirituality provided by Rabbis Algaze, Kraft and Sebrow and the extended Havurat family is the "secret sauce" that has firmly planted the Sosnowik family in Forest Hills. They want the children of the next generation to feel as connected to our faith, community and Israel as their daughter Dorit does. As David said at the dedication of the new shul, we are not builders, but "planters", carefully and patiently planting, nurturing, watering, pruning and protecting each and every one for as long as it requires.

THE HAVURAT YISRAEL IDEA - WHO ARE WE?

Havurat Yisrael was born on Purim night in 1981, when a young rabbi, David Algaze, created a veritable revolution in Queens, leading a group of mostly Conservative Jews onto a path of learning and inspiration that was to become one of the leading Orthodox synagogues in New York. The smell of popcorn that permeated the early services – held in a movie house on Austin Street, Forest Hills – became the talk of the town as well as a symbol of the innovation, warmth and originality of this Torah center.

The early activities of the synagogue were the creation of a camp retreat in the summer, a ski Shabbaton in Vermont in the winter and a host of new ideas and programs in between. The common aspect of all these programs was the desire to reach Jews of all backgrounds in every environment and every venue that they felt comfortable. Although this concept raised many an eyebrow at the beginning, many communities were soon adopting its programs and vision. Rabbi Algaze advocated the idea that a synagogue needs to be more than a house of worship in the formal sense; it must serve as a bridge and a path to discovery. Havurat Yisrael was founded on the idea of creating a community of learning and experience that will facilitate the path of teshuvah. Until today, you can enter a program at Havurat and feel that there is something special in the air. Some call it warmth, others friendship, but the real secret is: community (havurah).

Havurat initiated the first outreach programs in Queens. The first Beginners' Services and the first Turn Friday Night into Shabbat dinners were held there. The synagogue became a hub for singles throughout the metropolitan area and Rabbi Algaze has made numerous shidduchim through these gatherings and shabbatonim. One of the most successful bridges has been the one that connected people with a yeshiva background and people who did not know the aleph-bet. The sense of duty and service to Am Yisrael is one of the distinguishing traits of a Havurat Yisrael member. Acceptance,

the courage to innovate and accept diversity create a very profound atmosphere of unity of all Jews.

The "Drop in and Learn" program that was developed in conjunction with the Chafetz Chayim Yeshiva soon developed into a half-day Kollel under the leadership of Rabbi Eliahu Benhaim and Rabbi Algaze. This kollel was to produce several talmide hahamim and rabbis who are serving communities in Israel and Latin America. It is no wonder that groups of "alumni" of Havurat keep in touch with the synagogue regularly and proclaim its uniqueness.

Havurat has always lived beyond its walls. Spilling with joy onto the streets during Simchat Torah or offering a Perek shiur in the park in summertime, distributing mishloach manot on Purim or hanukkiot on Hanukkah to passers-by have endeared the synagogue to its host community and enabled Havurat to continue to attract more Jews to Torah and mitzvoth.

Havurat Yisrael believes that communities need bridging and connecting. It is therefore not uncommon to find at Havurat a mix of people in Hasidic garb mingling with people in jeans, Sephardim and Ashkenazim praying in an atmosphere of acceptance and sharing, people speaking different languages communicating with each other. But perhaps the most significant bridge has been to Eretz Israel. Havurat has always promoted an agenda of involvement in social issues and especially a connectedness and active involvement in the matters that affect the people and the land of Israel. Havurat has served for many years as the forum for many distinguished visitors from Israel, from politicians to rabbis, roshe yeshiva and activists. All have encountered an audience ready to learn and ready to act. That may be the most apt definition of Havurat: "learning in order to do".

THE HAVURAT YISRAEL FAMILY – WHAT WE DO

Learning is the foundation of Havurat Yisrael. From early morning till late at night, the classes, lectures, seminars and informal discussions shape the Havurat landscape. It is a place vibrant with intellectual stimulation and spiritual elevation. From the Learn to Read Hebrew class to the Jewish Living Laboratory, from the Parashat Hashavua class to the advanced Gemara shiur, there is a class for every level. The courses service a diverse community that includes young single adults, young marrieds, and newly arrived immigrants from Russia or Latin America. There are courses to accommodate the needs of these diverse groups.

A full range of family-oriented programs that appeal from the oldest to the youngest members of the family are offered in order to strengthen the ties that bind us together and to utilize the opportunity to learn from one another. Special dinners around the holidays allow people who would not have the ability to share in these experiences to enjoy them at Havurat. They include meals at Rosh Hashanah, Pesach Seders for the community, Tu Bishvat Seders, Lag Ba'omer celebrations and parties and hagigot for every occasion in the Jewish calendar. Even during the all-day fast days, there is learning and lectures by guest scholars. Rabbi Algaze has always encouraged the involvement of other rabbis and teachers in this enterprise and Havurat has been very lucky to have many distinguished rebbeim and lecturers in its history. Currently, the Rabbi is assisted by three rabbis who contribute to the success of Havurat's programs, each with his own flavor and characteristics. Rabbi Mordechai Kraft, a musmach of Chafetz Chayim Yeshiva, served as Youth Director and now is the Director of Outreach Programs and leads the Shabbat morning Beginners' Services, Rabbi Yaacov Sebrow, also ordained by the Chafetz Chayim and Rabbi Joel Hochman, who is a professor at Yeshiva University, is the popular teacher of a weekly class on the Parasha, and the director of adult education.

Rabbi Algaze saw long ago the need to incorporate singles in a full way in the programs of the synagogue. Havurat was the first synagogue in the area to offer single memberships and made every effort to make singles feel comfortable in the synagogue. Havurat organized shabbatonim and trips to help singles meet. In his career, Rabbi Algaze made well over 100 shidduchim. There are many more programs for singles that are being organized, including retreats outside of the community. Havurat is organizing Shabbatonim for singles in other cities. Rabbi Algaze created Priority Dating and there have been many successful programs under this original concept. The basic premise of Priority Dating is that self-discovery precedes the finding of a soul mate. (visit us at www.prioritydating.org) Even in its nomadic state, Havurat continues to thrive and the little house is bursting at the seams. The time has come now to build a Center appropriate to these functions
