We have strived to make Congregation Ahavas Achim as affordable as possible, so that those who are unable to afford membership elsewhere can join us. Our family dues are only \$650.00 per family and \$325.00 a year for an individual membership, with no additional charges for High Holy Day services. For those living over 50 miles away, we offer a Virtual Membership at a reduced rate.

Our congregation plays a major role in giving both adults and children a sense of Jewish identity, so important in this area. In addition, our congregation is small enough so that an individual's spiritual needs can be met in a warm, supportive and welcoming atmosphere. If you are looking for a friendly place to enjoy the holidays, say Yizkor for a departed one or want to explore your Jewish roots, please consider joining us. In the process, you will be helping maintain a Jewish presence in this area. We are happy to welcome those new to Judaism, members of interfaith marriages and their children. On request, our spiritual leader would be glad to talk to members about conversion, should that be a personal choice.

Message from the desk of Rabbi Shahar Colt:

Dear Ahavas Achim and Westfield Jewish Community,

It was a m'chayeh, a truly life-giving experience to be together at the end of June to celebrate Molly's bat mitzvah together. Experiencing a simcha in this community helped me appreciate more deeply the power of gathering together as Westfield's Jewish community. Though we may be small in numbers, we do powerful work to live real Jewish lives together - lives that radiate outwards and connect with so many others of all spiritual backgrounds.

I have been with this community for two and a half years now. As many of you know, I recently began a new full time position as the Assistant Director of Spiritual Life and Campus Rabbi at Amherst College. My family moved to Northampton- so much closer to Westfield than Boston! And so, in conversation with the CAA Board, we have decided that I will continue working with the community, though in a somewhat reduced capacity.

My Amherst schedule will conflict with CAA for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur, so we have hired Yitzi Gittelsohn, a rabbinical student at Hebrew College, to lead these services. Yitzi has regularly impressed me with his thoughtfulness, his commitment to Jewish spirituality, his openness to learning, and his integration of music. I have already started working with him to help him prepare for leading these services, and we will introduce him more fully in the coming months.

Aside from high holidays, I will be leading one shabbat service a month, as well as our Chanukah candle lighting, Passover seder and Jewish learning programs during the year.
