As an association, we want to ensure our members, families and children are safe while enjoying all the festivities at the campground. We hope everyone has a ton of fun while keeping safe. ~Thank You – Officers and Board of Directors

CCWHA Rules

- Everyone attending the ride(s), camping, or entering the campgrounds must purchase a membership and sign a waiver.
 All attendees must be age 18 to sign the waiver. Anyone age 17 and under must have an adult sign for them. MEMBERSHIPS
 AND CAMPSITES RESERVATIONS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.
- ALL MEMBERS ARE TO WEAR THEIR ARMBANDS ON THEIR ARMS. Armbands are required for the May and September rides. If you have your old armband, then you can receive a new armband free of charge. Otherwise, there is a \$5.00 charge for a new armband.
- 3. All horses by state law are required to have proof of a NEGATIVE COGGINS test as per a veterinarian, annually. Proof of a recent annual negative Coggins test is required each time a horse (re)enters the campground.
- 4. Everyone must obey state law when riding on the road and keep to the right side of the roadways.
- Do not ride on/in someone's yard or marked private properties. Anyone caught outside of the designated riding areas will
 be subject to have their membership(s) revoked. CCWHA is not liable for any legal action regarding trespassing/
 vandalism
- 6. No motorcycles, ATVs, or bicycles on the campground.
- 7. No beverage containers on the dance floor.
- 8. No glass bottles.
- 9. No trucks or horses on or around the dance floor, at any time, under no circumstances.
- 10. No firearms or weapons allowed. Anyone caught with firearms, weapons, etc. must leave the campground and will be subject to a lifetime suspension.
- 11. No fireworks of any kind allowed.

4 and Under - Free

- 12. Tie all horses by 8:00 pm Friday/Saturday night and half an hour after the horse show ends on Sunday night.
- 13. No cruising the campground/noisy activities after 1:00 am each night.
- 14. Everyone must help keep the campground clean. No permanent structures (including outhouses, stalls, spools, tables or chairs) allowed. All items left behind are subject to removal/destruction at owner's expense.
- 15. TAKE ALL TRASH WITH YOU WHEN YOU LEAVE. If your site has trash still on it when you leave you will be subject to a Fine!
- 16. No fences of any kind permitted (including electric, solar, barbwire, ropes, etc.).
- 17. Due to tree damage at the campground, avoid tying horses to the trees. Picket lines are allowed. DO NOT tie horses or picket lines to utility poles. There is a \$50.00 fine for each tree damaged at your campsite.
- 18. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR PET(S) AT ALL TIMES. Pets must be on a leash or confined to your campsite at all times. IF YOU DO NOT ABIDE BY THIS RULE, THEN YOU MUST LEAVE THE CAMPGROUND.
- 19. Anyone selling food/drinks on the campground, other than the concession stand, must leave the campground.
- 20. Portable toilets permitted, but considered a PUBLIC RESTROOM(S).
- 21. When you buy a membership, it does not include a campsite. Campsites, except the reservation only sites, may be marked off two weeks prior to each CCWHA scheduled event. There must be a contact name, phone number and date of when campsite was marked physically visible on actual campsite(s). Board members will resolve all campsite disagreements, if members cannot resolve the situation themselves.
- 22. Any person(s) intentionally harming another person(s), another person(s) property, or instigating such behavior must leave the campground. All parties involved will be subject to have their membership(s) revoked and THE CANNON COUNTY POLICE WILL BE CALLED.
- 23. CCWHA reserves the right to ask anyone not complying with the CCWHA rules to leave and may revoke their membership.
- 24. Law officials/security personnel will be instructed to enforce the laws and rules.
