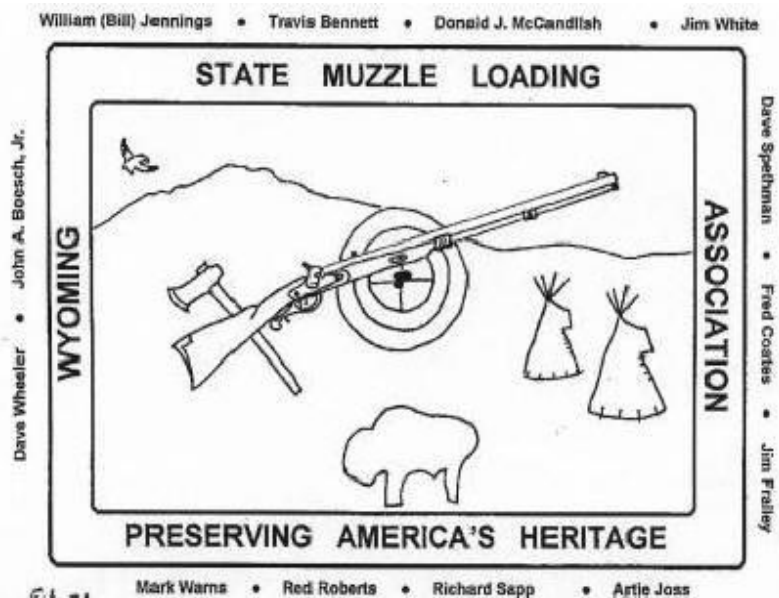


Wyoming State Muzzleloader Association's News

Trish Miller, is the Director/ Convention Chair. Term expires in 2020.



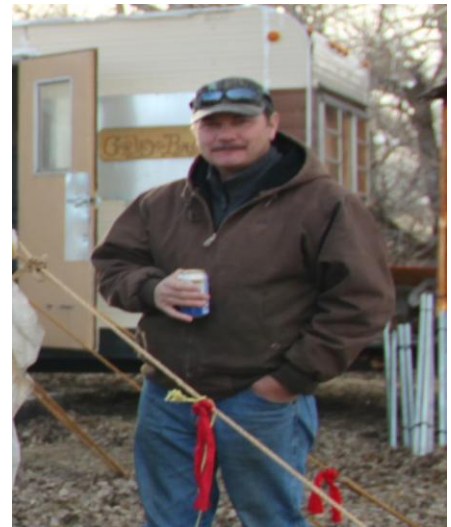
