GENERAL REMINDERS/ANNOUNCMENTS:

- Updated policies have been added to the website under the by-laws and covenants tab. Please familiarize yourself with these updated policies. These new policies cover meeting conduct, procedures for collection of unpaid assessments, and policies and procedures for covenant and rule enforcement. Hard copies can be requested if desired.
- Ice melt is for anyone in the community who wants it and is located by the mail shed.
- With spring cleaning coming up please remember that all items being thrown away must **fully** fit in the dumpster. No items are to be left in the area around the dumpster. Items being given away must be taken to goodwill or arc or listed on places like Facebook marketplace. No items are allowed to be left outside.
- If you would like to do a garage sale, remember you are limited to the space directly in front of your garage.
- All doors need to be painted the correct color within a month of being replaced. Paint codes can be found on the website.

PARKING REMINDERS:

- Each homeowner is responsible for their guest's parking. Please ensure they are parking in visitor spots. Homeowners have the right to tow vehicles parked in their spots.
- If a guest is planning on staying more than 4 hours in a guest spot, please let a board member know.
- Please do not let your visitors park in the visitor parking lot if we are expecting snow. This is where the snow gets plowed to.
- Guest parking is for visitors ONLY. Do not park in visitor parking if you live in the complex. Violators will be towed at owner expense.

Monthly Dues

Dues are \$195.00 per month, due by the first of the month.

Dues MUST be mailed. Please do not hand deliver to anyone on the board.

Many people have asked if dues can be paid electronically. Online Bill Pay lets you make recurring electronic payments. Your bank or credit union will mail a check directly to the HOA. If your bank offers this, add Woody Creek Townhome Association #I as an individual biller, add payment amount, and the HOA address. Please note, the HOA will not be releasing any bank account information for this process.

If you are having trouble paying on time or are behind on your monthly dues, please contact the Treasurer at treasurer@woodycreektownhome.com to set up a reasonable payment plan. Payment plans must be submitted in writing and approved by the board.



- Pick up days are Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Trash is not picked up on holidays.
- WE ARE CHARGED FOR OVERFILLED DUMPSTERS AND TRASH ON THE GROUND - Help us avoid these fees. If you notice a dumpster is overflowing, please find a less-full dumpster or wait until trash is next picked up. Please place trash entirely in the dumpster and clean up anything you drop.
- Visitors do not have dumping privileges. Please ensure your guests are not dumping their trash in our receptacles.
- Fines will be enforced for those who leave trash in areas that impede the use of the dumpster for other homeowners.
