A diocesan offering which has been used solely within our diocese as a way of funding projects that will improve, enhance or fulfill a need pertaining to parish buildings.

History of ASDMO

This diocesan project was first known as the Corporate Gift Offering and then called the Advance Work Offering. Money collected was used to enlarge or strengthen work in the missionary field at home and abroad. Offering was established in 1919 by ECW.

Since 1937

The offering has been used solely within this diocese as a way of funding projects that would improve, enhance or fulfill a need pertaining to parish buildings.

At the 1949 Annual Episcopal Church Women (ECW), the women voted to change the name from Advance Work Offering to All Saints Day Memorial Offering.

Monies are given as living memorials of loved ones now deceased, and are collected in November on a Sunday nearest All Saints Day.
