

Important Announcement from The State of Georgia:



Voting has been Suspended due to the COVID-19 Virus.

Due to mounting concerns over the Covid-19 Virus and the current State of Emergency, Secretary Raffensperger has moved the Presidential Preference Primary (and attached special elections) from March 24, 2020 to coincide with the State Primary scheduled for May 19, 2020.

All in-person absentee voting ended on Saturday March 14, 2020.

There will be no more in-person voting until in-person voting begins for the May 19, 2020 state primary in April.

The Presidential Preference Primary (and associated special elections) has been moved/ postponed. It has not been canceled.

Every vote already cast, whether by mail or in person, WILL be counted in May for the Presidential Preference Primary and any local special elections along with votes cast in the state primary.

Knowing that we cannot know what the situation will be like in two months, our office will be strongly encouraging absentee by mail voting for the May election.
