Utility Tax Information

Overview: Rockford Town Council will soon be adopting an ordinance to place utility taxes, at a rate of 25% for sewer and 10% for water, on the income received through providing these services. Utility taxes are imposed upon the utility business itself (the town), and not upon the individual utility customers.

How does this affect your bill? In short, it doesn't. This is NOT an additional charge to our water/sewer customers. This is a tax to the already existing income and allows the town to transfer the "tax" amount from the Water/Sewer Fund into the General Fund. From the General Fund, the income can be used for streets, parks, capital facilities, etc. Please call Town Hall or email townclerk@rockfordwa.com with any questions.
