Becky Brown's popular Horsemanship Summer Camp will be offered again this year, at our new home in Cedar Hill. Camps for complete beginners to advanced riders meet Monday through Friday. Pony Kamp ages 5-7 meet Monday-Thursday. In addition to riding, each session covers safety, grooming, tacking up, veterinary care, and more. Classes are grouped according to age and skill level with qualified instructors, well-trained horses and lots of one-on-one attention. Please send your camper in appropriate riding attire: long pants or breeches, riding helmet (some available to loan), and boots or hard soled shoes with a 1" heel (no sneakers or hiking boots & we have some available to loan). Also include a snack (refrigeration available) & water jug.

### **COVID-19 Safety Protocols:**

As an outdoor activity camp, we are well-positioned to adopt the CDC guidelines for summer camp.

- Every staff member & every camper will have their temperature taken at the start of the day, with a no-touch thermometer
- Hand sanitizing stations will be at the groom/tacking area
- We ask that campers wear riding gloves that should be washed often. Please note, campers should still sanitize hands regularly and before getting in the car to return home
- Common areas will be thoroughly wiped down every morning prior to camp start
- We ask that each camper bring his or her own water bottle
- Horsemanship portions (i.e. non-mounted activities) will be organized with social distancing
- Spectators are welcome; we have plenty of chairs in the indoor arena and ask that you leave 2 empty chairs between

## Camp Descriptions and Fees:

**Level I - Pony Camp:** Open to 5-7 yr olds with little or no riding experience. Campers will ride and learn horsemanship theory appropriate for age. Taught in a fun playful atmosphere. These spots fill fast! Monday-Thursday. Fee \$325

**Level II - Beginner/Intermediate Camp:** Divided into two sections: first time riders and riders of limited riding experience. Includes arena and trail riding, horsemanship theory, riding games and lots of fun!  
Minimum age: 8 years old. Fee: \$475

**Level III - Intermediate Camp:** For riders who have taken lessons for more than a year and are comfortable at walk, trot, canter, and over small fences. Limited enrollment. Fee: \$575

**Level IV - Advanced Competition Camp:** Open to riders comfortable jumping 2'6" with basic dressage skills. Students will explore the new cross-country jumping course! Included will be intense theory and practicum on riding, nutrition, and basic vet skills. Limited enrollment. Fee: \$575

**Adult Evening Camp:** Beginner-Competition: Curriculum includes dressage lessons, small fences and an evening trail ride. Level of riding will be determined by applicant's prior experience dates decided as enrollees state their preference.
