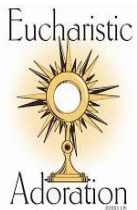

FROM FR. VICTOR

Dear Parishioners, in Christ,

Well we just opened St. Stephen's. This is an emotional time for many people of our parishes. For some there is joy because the church is back open and they are able to attend it and support it. The Mass I celebrated there was beautiful and there was no more standing room in the Church even. All the doors had to remain open so that people standing outside could see and hear.

For other there might be some perplexity and even frustration, not because St. Stephen's is open but that the merger was undone. I know that many of you worked and prepared for two years before the merger happened. This took mental energy and hearing about the merger for many years. You guys had a slogan, signage, you promoted this idea of unity.

You guys have been through a lot, both parishioners from St. Joseph and those from St. Stephen. Parishioners left because St. Stephen's was

closed. But also St. Joseph parishioners left because of the changed Mass times. I know also that you had to have many different priests to be here as pastor or administrator of St. Joseph and then the change to St. Joseph-St. Stephen's. This is not fun for the priest nor for you the congregation. We are thankful to Fr. Luke and Fr. Sal for their commitment to the community. I want you to know that I appreciate you guys weathering the storm and staying here. I am totally dedicated to you and helping this Church grow. I hope to bring stability to this parish and to the people who will attend St. Stephen's as well since they can find me both here and there. And I hope people from St. Stephen's will see this as a second home in the arms of St. Joseph the Patron of the universal Church and patron of the Josefinos.

Even though St. Stephen's is opened we are forever touched by our union with St. Stephen's. We can't turn back the clock to pre-merger conditions. All what you have been through is not for naught. There are parishioners who are staying from St. Stephen's here at St. Joseph. The Mass schedule will remain the same. We will only lose the 2:00 p.m. Spanish Mass.

One of my main focuses is the Youth. We will serve here the youth who attend here or there. They are baptized all brothers and sisters. There is no us and them in the household of God. We are all one. We witness to the Kingdom of God. We are all the youth of one Father.

Our focus needs to be on preaching the Gospel here and forming the people who are here. I will work with those who register at St. Stephen's on how to best bring the Gospel and form the people who are at St. Stephen's in their current conditions with the office here and the youth here. I will work with parishioners to make sure St. Stephen's is financially stable. CCE will continue here at St. Joseph for the foreseeable future. And we are blessed now the day after the opening of St. Stephen's to find out that we have parking available on Sunday on Lubbock street for free. Thank you to Martha Montalvo parishioner and former HPD police chief for helping this happen.

So there will be more parking for people to come from St. Stephen's for CCE on Sunday and for all

Mass goers to have more places to park. Do not park near the stop sign.

So I do believe God will bring a greater good out of this. Let us remember God walks with us. If you would like to come and talk to me or to have a visit to your house let me know. I am happy to be here as your pastor. God bless.

Como saben acabamos de abrir San Esteban. Este es un momento emocionante para muchas personas de nuestras parroquias. Tienen alegría porque la iglesia está abierta de nuevo y pueden asistir y apoyarla. La misa que celebré allí fue hermosa y ni siquiera había más espacio para estar de pie en la Iglesia. Trabajaré con los feligreses para asegurarme de que San Esteban sea financieramente estable. CCE continuará en San José en el futuro previsible.

Y ahora estamos bendecidos el día después de la inauguración de San Esteban para descubrir que tenemos estacionamiento disponible el domingo en la calle Lubbock de forma gratuita. Gracias a Martha Montalvo feligrés y ex jefa de policía de HPD por ayudar a que esto suceda. Entonces habrá más estacionamientos para que la gente venga de San Esteban a CCE el domingo y para que todos los asistentes a la misa tengan más lugares para estacionar.
