### Looking to a new meeting place

Your church board of trustees has taken a good look around Paradise and done some background work to get ready for when we have the opportunity to meet once again for worship.

Their finding? The "old" church in the back parking area of St. Nicholas' Episcopal Church (accessed from the parking lot at 5872 Oliver) will provide the space for our congregation when the COVID restrictions are lifted. The little red building was built in 1950 as St. Nicholas' first church; it was replaced in 2000 when a new sanctuary was built and it was moved to the back of the church's property.

It offers plenty of parking, easy accessibility and a manageable size for our smaller congregation. Trustees also hope to hold their meetings in the building, as COVID restrictions permit.
