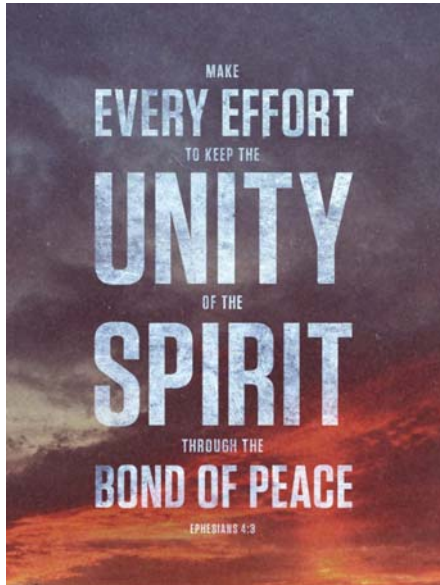


**“Make Every Effort to Keep the Unity” -
