Last week, the squad took three out of four games. BHS swept Legacy, 5-3, 8-0, and split at Mandan, winning, 4-0, and losing 6-2. The Demons had a pair of shutout wins last week. CENTURY: The top-ranked Patriots (2016: 5-1 Overall; 5-1 WDA) face Bismarck High on Tuesday, April 12 and travels to Williston on Friday, April 15.
