DESCRIPTION: This is an attractive 1968 modified Shakespeare Kaibab. Zebrawood and Bengé riser. This bow is now a semi-recurve. One tip was broken off, so I cut off both tips at the overlay and installed new tip overlays on both sides of the limb. This shortened the bow to AMO 54", and increased the draw weight to 55"@28". The modifications caused the bow to begin to stack at 26", so I would not recommend it for anyone with a draw length longer than 26". This bow is still shoots surprisingly fast. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Double-sided overlay tips. Overlays and tips are new. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there, including some near one of the tips (see left pic on p. 3). Some minor discoloration of the green limbs. Decals are in good condition. If the original tip hadn't been broken, this bow would sell in the \$180-\$200 range.
