#### **EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT (ESG)**

Funding through Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) to assist homeless individuals and families to gain or maintain housing.

- Must have a financial crisis within the last 60 days
- Must have a legal eviction notice or be literally homeless (either in shelter, living on the street or in place not meant for human habitation)
- But for this assistance be literally homeless (all other resource attempted)



#### **HOMELESS PREVENTION**

Funding provided through the Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS) to assist individuals and families with one time assistance with rent/deposit to prevent homelessness

- Income under 200% Poverty
- Proven financial crisis within the last 90 days
- One time assistance
- Rent must be affordable no more than 50% of net income
- Must not have received help in the last 2 years
- Lack financial resources to prevent homelessness without assistance

#### **VOUCHER SHELTER**

Funding provided through the Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS) to assist individuals with voucher shelter in an emergency situation to prevent homelessness.

- Income under 200% poverty level.
- Must be literally homeless and unable to stay at a homeless shelter.
- Must lack financial resources to obtain shelter on their own.
- Must not have received help in the last 2 years

#### PERMANENT SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

Funding provided through HUD to serve chronically homeless and disabled. Supportive services are offered to maximize housing stability and prevent return to homelessness. The ultimate goal of the program is to help those chronically homeless find permanent housing without needing support.

- Must be disabled and chronically homeless
- Must agree to work with a case manager on an ongoing basis
