**First Lesson** Genesis 32:22-32 [22](#) And he arose that night and took his two wives, his two female servants, and his eleven sons, and crossed over the ford of Jabbok.[23](#) He took them, sent them over the brook, and sent over what he had.[24](#) Then Jacob was left alone; and a Man wrestled with him until the breaking of day.[25](#) Now when He saw that He did not prevail against him, He touched the socket of his hip; and the socket of Jacob's hip was out of joint as He wrestled with him.[26](#) And He said, "Let Me go, for the day breaks." But he said, "I will not let You go unless You bless me!"[27](#) So He said to him, "What is your name?" He said, "Jacob."[28](#) And He said, "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with God and with men, and have prevailed."[29](#) Then Jacob asked, saying,

"Tell me Your name, I pray." And He said, "Why is it that you ask about My name?" And He blessed him there.[30](#) And Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: "For I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved."[31](#) Just as he crossed over Peniel the sun rose on him, and he limped on his hip.[32](#) Therefore to this day the children of Israel do not eat the muscle that shrank, which is on the hip socket, because He touched the socket of Jacob's hip in the muscle that shrank.

**Second Lesson** James 3:1-12 [1](#) My brethren, let not many of you become teachers, knowing that we shall receive a stricter judgment.[2](#) For we all stumble in many things. If anyone does not stumble in word, he is a perfect man, able also to bridle the whole body.[3](#) Indeed, we put bits in horses' mouths that they may obey us, and we turn their whole body.[4](#) Look also at ships: although they are so large and are driven by fierce winds, they are turned by a very small rudder wherever the pilot desires.[5](#) Even so the tongue is a little member and boasts great things. See how great a forest a little fire kindles![6](#) And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. The tongue is so set among our members that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire by hell.[7](#) For every kind of beast and bird, of reptile and creature of the sea, is tamed and has been tamed by mankind.[8](#) But no man can tame the tongue. It is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.[9](#) With it we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the similitude of God.[10](#) Out of the same mouth proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be so.[11](#) Does a spring send forth fresh water and bitter from the same opening?[12](#) Can a fig tree, my brethren, bear olives, or a grapevine bear figs? Thus no spring yields both salt water and fresh.
