Due to the many class A and 3A teams coming into class 2A, redistricting based off of past districts became very difficult. Because of the A and 3A factor, it also became a challenge to determine the strength of a district.

The NW and SW became the only two areas that were able to keep a resemblance of their previous districts.

We also took into consideration what other districts and areas a school historically played in.

*Northwest

The travel in this area of the state has always been a concern, so in order to fill an eight team district we had to bring two teams from the metro area.

OCS and Luther have previously been in the northwest district, and this also allowed us to keep intact a previous district

City/Metro area

The city area always contains many options for district realignment. This year was no different, but the factors in the surrounding metro area districts led us to the decision to create District 2

In order to have 16 teams available for the SW and Southern districts; we felt it was necessary to bring Kellyville from the SW Tulsa area to the Eastern City district.

South Metro and SW/Southern Region

This was an area that became very difficult to divide due to travel, three previous 3A teams, and two previous Class A teams.

It was determined early on that Coalgate and Frederick could not be in the same district due to a 185 mile and 3 hour plus drive for each school. Because of this factor, we were forced to either send two western or two eastern schools to district 3. After looking at all travel and balance of power options, we decided that Frederick would need to be in district 3 with Lindsay; thus allowing Purcell to be the farthest northern member of District 4.

Southeast

This was also an area where travel became a concern.

We felt that our best option was to add Idabel to this district and keep Eufaula with District 6 for a balance of power.

Eastern and Tulsa area

This is an area where travel to district 5 and balance of power within the Tulsa area became huge factors in determining each of the three remaining districts.

In the previous realignment Holland Hall traveled to district 5 from the Tulsa area, so with that in mind we decided to move Cascia Hall and Rejoice Christian into district 5.

OFBCA executive boards suggestions

*2A-1 & 2A-2 stayed the same

*With districts 3 & 4, Frederick and Holdenville were switched b/c of a better fit geographically and switched Lindsay and Purcell because of the same reasons. Still felt balance of power was reasonable.

*In 2A-5 we took Rejoice out and replaced with Keys for geographical purposes.

*2A-6 stayed the same

*In districts 7 & 8 we switched Sperry and Metro because of a better fit geographically.

*2A-8 loses Keys and replaced with Rejoice Christian
