#### Words from the Pastor

Dear friends:

Our Annual Congregational Meeting was held Sunday, January 28. I would like to recap some of my thoughts from my Annual Report for the benefit of those who could not attend.

I have been your Interim Pastor for one year and two months. I very much appreciate both the love and support you have given me and my new bride, the Rev. Shari Maddox. We were married on July 22 at St. John United Church of Christ in Chesterfield, MO where she is a member. We were honored that many members of New Horizons attended the wedding and reception. We are now living in Chesterfield.

Last year, I encouraged the Session to engage in conversations with all the members of the congregation about the future of your congregation The Worship and Nurture Committee took up this task and we had three "Sundays of Assessment" held in September and October. A report was compiled and presented to the Session in November. At a joint meeting of the Session and Deacons (along with other interested members), there was a discussion of next steps held on January 21, 2018. Three guestions were discussed and consensus was reached on two: 1.) We will stay open. 2.) We will seek a part time, installed pastor called by the congregation, The third question about merger or joint ministry with another church will require more thought and discussion.

Let me say a few more words about ministry with other churches and/or denominations. It is possible for congregations to share ministry with other congregations without merger. For example, congregations can yoke; this means

they share a pastor, but they maintain their own identity, building, and programs. This can happen across denomination boundaries, mostly easily with the United Church of Christ and Evangelical Lutherans (ELCA). (We have full communion agreements with them so that ministers from one of these denominations can serve in another.)

I am pleased that our congregation already participates with other churches in the Ritenour Ministerial Association. The Community Lenten Luncheons offer a delightful blend of blue-grass music, food, fellowship, and Bible study. The lunches were held in our Fellowship Hall every Thursday during Lent on 2017. They will continue this year at West Side General Baptist Church on Wismer Road. There was also a Community Thanksgiving Service at Overland Baptist Church in November; surely another will be held this year.. The offerings collected at these services support the Ritenour Rent and Utility Program, which is now an independent ministry of the Ministerial Association.

I am also grateful for the worship and music ministry of New Horizons, especially the dedicated choir and their director Barb McHugh. A highlight was the Christmas Cantata presented at the Sunday morning service on Christmas Eve. The Christmas Eve Candlelight Communion Service was the first time my wife, the Rev. Shari Maddox, and I had co-celebrated communion. We thank you for the opportunity.

Shari is also assisting me in another delightful responsibility of my ministry with you: teaching Confirmation Class. Classes began on January 18 and are held on Thursday afternoons after school. We have two students, Samantha and Julia Lohnes and we are looking forward to their professions of faith on Easter, April 1.
