JENNINGS TO SPEAK ON ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN

Local Architect Walter Jennings, AIA, LEED AP will lead an educational and entertaining program using photos and stories that highlight design incorporated into some of his firms most notable projects to include Hunt Chapel.

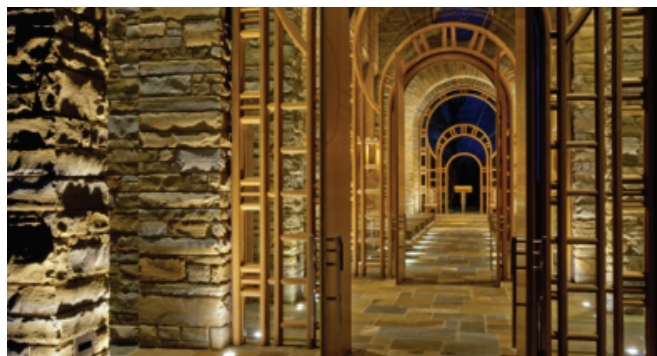
Walter received his Bachelor of Architecture along with Minors in Physics and Studio Art from the University of Arkansas in 2001. His interests in green and sustainable architecture lead to his LEED accreditation in 2002. Walter is a partner with his father in the Fayetteville firm of Maurice Jennings + Walter Jennings Architects, PLLC where they focus on principles of Organic Architecture. These principles include a harmony between

the building and its natural surroundings, a close relationship of the individual elements of a building to each other, a generous use of natural light, and the honest expression of materials. The firm provides a full range of architectural services consisting of the design, design development, and services during construction for all types of projects, especially residences and chapels.

Walter Jennings is a modern-day Renaissance man. A 2001 graduate of the University of Arkansas, he earned a bachelor's in architecture with minors in physics and studio art. "Architecture pulls a lot of things together, and

you want to be a well-informed generalist," he explained. "Sometimes it is nice to understand a little bit of everything." In school, he interned at his father's firm. At graduation, though, he decided it would be good to gain experience on his own. He went to work at HOK Sport, now called Populous, in Oklahoma City. The company designs stadiums and large sporting arenas. But Walter missed designing the

smaller-scale projects his dad specialized in, mainly homes and chapels, so he returned to Fayetteville in 2004. He considers being licensed and being a partner in the firm with his father his biggest achievements. Jennings is a current member of the Washington County Planning Board. Outside of work, Jennings is a firefighter with the Round Mountain Volunteer Fire Department, and a member of the county's Urban Search and Rescue team and its board.
