



VOTE ON PROPOSED CHANGES TO BYLAWS

- Article V officially add a 2nd Vice President, & require that candidates for president have previously served on the board
- Article X specify fund disbursement reasons, disbursements require 2 approvals, 2 signatures required for \$5,000+ checks,
 & allow for debit cards in lieu of credit cards
