# **President's Message**

We changed the Saturday Skins Game and discovered some issues with the new format. The board of directors of your club wants to accommodate as many members as possible, and will be moving forward with a new format that we think will resolve most of the issues if not all of them.

Starting with June 22, 2013 we will be asking for your current handicap index when you call in for a tee time or at time of paying the pot money. The format (three flights), here is how it would work with 40 players. Total money with 40 players would be \$600. Low net of \$20 in each flight totals \$60. One field for the closest to the pins at \$20 each would total \$80. That leaves \$460 for the three skins pots or \$153 per pot. There would be 13/14 players in each flight. A & B flights would be gross skins and C flight would be net skins. Payouts per flight would be as follows:

- -2 skins—\$76 each
- -3 skins—\$51 each
- -4 skins—\$38 each
- -5 skins—\$30 each
- -6 skins—\$25 each.

These are reasonable payouts; not as high as when there are only two flights but still decent.

John Kramer will no longer run the Skins game on Saturdays; Doug Benc will replace him. You can sign-up for the Saturday skins game by going to the web site elpradomensclub.com and entering your preferences under the comment section (Preferable method) or by calling or texting (772) 408-2421 and leave Doug a message. Doug will only be collecting the \$15 pot money. You need to pay in the golf shop all other fees.

The El Prado Golf Courses along with the El Prado Men's Golf Club is putting together a Pro Am golf tournament, tentatively scheduled for November 1, 2013. We would like to have 66 Men's club members and 22 PGA Golf Pros compete for cash. Each foursome will consist of 1 PGA Pro and 3 amateurs. There will be a putting contest, longest drive, and closest to the pin. Afterward there may be a speaker, possibly a magician and an awards banquet. The cost will be \$100 each covering the round of golf, cart, range balls and the Banquet.

Those of you who have been around will remember how much fun it was when they used to have the Pro AM. We would like to get this back on an annual basis. If you are interested, we need you to please contact my self or Greg Entrup as soon as possible to gauge the probable participation. Further updates to follow in next month's newsletter!
