From the Pastoral Associate: All of us can be "the nudge." Regrettably, sometimes any one of us can be the nudge of evil that was "the straw that broke the camel's back." It was our rude comment, our sarcastic remark, our decision to not get involved, our negative comment added to all the others that was the last straw that helped sorrow come about. It works the other way too. Anyone of us can be the instrument of the Holy Spirit that speaks a word of encouragement, that asks, "May I help?" or gives a sincere compliment. We can be that last nudge of our whispering God that invites, "Why don't you come to Mass with me?" "Would you like to talk about it?" "Would you like to pray with me about it?" We can be nudge of the reassurance of the presence of the Kingdom of God by telling someone of the good things the Lord has done for us. We can be the reassurance that is needed to tell someone that no matter what we have done God will forgive us if we are sorry. Don't let Satan's LIE that, "God does not want you," which is aimed at a grieving person's heart rule the dark silence of doubt and lead to despair. We can be the speaker of the TRUTH that, "God is a loving and forgiving God who wants even the worst sinner" and this truth can bring God's light and joy into that person's being. We can be the nudge of a challenging friend that says. "Have you thought about becoming Catholic? I would help you by being your sponsor.", "Have you thought about making things right with the Lord", "Have you thought about giving 'this problem', or 'your life' to God?" We can be the nudge that leads someone to consider seeking the TRUTH, "What do you think God would want you to do?" Yes, we may get rebuked, rebuffed or even scorned. Yes, this person may need a few more nudges from God's other helpers to get to the point of claiming their inheritance of God's love and life by accepting Jesus as their Savior. But we should be OK with being rebuked. We are living as disciples/friends of Christ and we should never apologize for that. Let us ask our Father in prayer to have the Holy Spirit direct our eyes, ears and heart to be His instruments of love, truth and hope in the world and not be thoughtlessly or prayerlessly a tool of the evil one. ~ Michael Pekar
