(Philippians 1:11) May you always be filled with the fruit of your salvation—the righteous character produced in your life by Jesus Christ—for this will bring much glory and praise to God.

Cultivating Character in a World of Compromise

1. Plow the Soil – Soften your heart

2. Plant the Seed - Receive God's Word

3. Beat the Heat – Embrace trials as opportunities

(Romans 5:3-4) We can rejoice, too, when we run into problems and trials, for we know that they help us develop endurance. And endurance develops strength of character, and character strengthens our confident hope of salvation.

4. Share the Work – Seek Support (Small Group)

(Proverbs 12:26) The godly give good advice to their friends; the wicked lead them astray.
