1. Who participates in the **HOME ALONE in Cary Gymnastics**?

All gymnasts from Recreational and Team Classes are invited to participate. Participation is not mandatory, but highly encouraged. All gymnasts have worked INCREDIBLY hard this year. This would be a great opportunity for family members to come and see the wonderful progress each child has made. The environment will be laid back and performed in a familiar atmosphere with friends. Each level will showcase specific "routines" during the performance.

2. What day and time will the show take place?

The show is Sunday, Dec 9^{th} at 2pm. We ask all gymnasts to arrive between 1:15 pm-1:30pm for warm-ups.

3. My child isn't attending. How will that effect classes?

Gymnastics is about creating and learning skills that when put together forms a routine. The class is NOT structured around the showcase. Gymnasts still enrolled in a class, but are not participating in the performance, will continue to receive a productive class setting that allows them to learn how to put elements together (forming a routine).

4. Where will the **HOME ALONE in Cary Gymnastics** be held?

At Cary Gymnastics Center on Sunday, Dec. 9th at 2pm. Students will sit in the recreational gym until their specific group is called up to perform. Parents, family and friends love to have the opportunity to see their gymnasts perform, so there are sure to be many "Kodak" moments.

5. Do I have to pre-register for **HOME ALONE in Cary Gymnastics**?

Yes. Not only do we have to prepare and plan, but each gymnast gets a complimentary shirt as a memento for this special event. Enrollment must be done by December 2nd (by registering online and making payment in full at that time). Last minute enrollees will not be allowed unfortunately.

6. Is there a fee required for this event?

Yes, we will offer an early registration fee of \$35 per gymnast participating by November 25th, 2018. Any enrollments between November 26^{th} -December 2nd, the registration fee will be \$40 per gymnast.

7. Do I have to purchase a costume?

No. To keep costs down, we will give each class a theme. With that theme you can get as wild and crazy as you would like. Gymnasts need to be able to safely perform their routines without any obstructions. Information will be emailed on a class by class basis letting you know what the theme will be.

8. Are tickets required?

Yes, tickets are \$2 each if purchased by December 2nd. After December 2nd, tickets can be purchased for \$4 each. This fee is charged due to the expenses incurred leading up to and during the performance. Tickets are NOT needed for children under the age of 5 sitting on a lap, or for children participating in the show.

9. Is there assigned seating?

We conveniently allow seating on a first come first serve basis. We have folding chair seating, as well as reserved handicap seating.
