President's Preface

Dear Members, Students, and Friends,

Le 14 juillet / the 14th of July

Our thanks to all that attended our Annual General Meeting and Fête de la Musique on June 21st. We appreciate your continued support.

July 14th commemorates the storming of the Bastille in Paris on that date in 1789 during the French Revolution. The Bastille had served as a fortress and brutal prison for political prisoners (often not formally charged with any crime) under King Louis 16th, but also housed gunpowder and ammunition for the French Army and the King's mercenaries. The crowd seized the arms and released the prisoners as they overran the Bastille. That event is effectively considered to be the end of the monarchy and the feudal system in France. A year later, on the same date in 1790, the Festival of the Federation celebrated the unity of France and peace.

While many English-speaking countries call this day "Bastille Day," it is simply the 14th of July in France. The day is celebrated in Paris with a massive military parade along the Champs-Elysées, and many other festivals throughout France and in many countries around the word, including 50 cities in the U.S.

The holiday is analogous to America's Independence Day, now just referred to as July 4th. The U.S.A. birthday celebrates the signing of our Declaration of Independence by delegates from each of the 13 (then) English colonies.

Whatever you celebrate this July, the 4th or the 14th, we wish you all an excellent day. Actually, there is no harm in celebrating both – Enjoy!
