Re: Off Season Security Concerns

Dear John:

Thank you for your letter dated September 17, 2010 regarding off season security concerns in Waskesiu.

Upon consulting with the local RCMP detachment, the Waskesiu Community Council and Prince Albert National Park staff a pilot gate installation project has been agreed to as a means of deterring break and enter activity in residential subdivisions in Waskesiu.

For the time period of November 2010 to the end of March 2011, the Park will place New Jersey barriers on Ajaawan Road and install chain gates to block access to Tamarack Street and access to both entrances to the Prospect Point subdivision. A gate entry protocol has been developed, to control access to these areas, should members of the public or contractors need to access these areas during this time period.

Sgt Gabriel from the Waskesiu, RCMP detachment advises that it may be possible to have surveillance equipment installed to compliment the Park gates but nothing has been confirmed to date.

Trusting this addresses your associations concerns regarding this matter.
