**CORRESPONDENCE**

**1. Program Director Position for Summer Recreation Program- Jeralyn Dalling**

V. Galizia had spoken with Ms. Dalling who stated that it would cost her too much to obtain the liability insurance to cover the children in the program. The town is not able to cover the program since she is not a township employee.
