# February Program American Sweetheart in Monax

American Sweetheart was produced by MacBeth Evans from 1930-36 in Toledo Ohio. They were bought by Corning Glassware and the pattern was produced from 1937-1940. It has heat strength and durability.

Christian began collecting this pattern with her Grandmother.

The first pieces being flat rimmed soup bowls.





She has that lovely 20" platter, 1 cream soup bowl, 9" berry bowls, chop plate (with figure in the middle), salad plate (plain middle), cream and sugar (without lid), oval tray and bowl, bread/butter plate. She does not have lampshades or the salt/peppers.

This pattern originally came in 15 piece sets: 12" server, 4 cups, 4 saucers, 4 salads, and cream & sugar.
