1921-1987

Frances Elizabeth "Buddy" Shotwell, age 66 of New Smyrna Beach, Fla. and Naubinway, Mich., passed away Tuesday morning, April 21 at her home in New Smyrna Beach, from complications following cancer.

She was born Jan. 4, 1921 in Duluth, Minn., daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Simon A. "Samuel" Tessman.
