Cheese Blintz Soufflé

a.k.a. Trail Dusters Square Dance Club Soufflé

Ingredients



Arlene Zoren eating her cheese soufflé (see recipe on the right)

12 cheese blintzes (2 boxes ~ frozen) – Golden brand is best 1 stick of butter 4 eggs

1 large sour cream (16 oz)

1-1/2 teaspoons vanilla

1/4 cup sugar

2 Tbsp orange juice (optional)

Colden Potato-Bintzes

Directions

Melt butter Roll frozen blintzes in butter – one at a time Place blintzes in 9x13 casserole (2 rows) Beat: eggs, sour cream, sugar, vanilla, orange juice Pour over blintzes Bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour Let stand for 10 minutes
