After eating, and a 45 minute nap, (just kidding about the nap) we got down to business, discussing job assignments, and nailing down details concerning our event, which i believe is the 34th year. How I Got involved with Corvairs – this month from Chuck Smith

My Corvair story began back in 1962, when I was a mere child of three. I barely remember us having a 1957 Ford sedan, which Dad traded for a '62 Corvair 700 4-door, at Dunlap Chevrolet, in Macon,Ga. It was white, with either a dark blue or dark green interior. Don't remember the engine, but I recall it had a 3-speed transmission. It had the fold down back seat, and I remember going to drive-in movies, and having all of that space to play, and eventually fall asleep. My Dad was a breadman back then, and McDonalds was one of his customers. I remember us taking buns to them on some Saturday evenings, and of course they were in the trunk! We didn't keep the Corvair long; he traded it for a 1963 Dodge.

Fast forward to around 1984. The Corvair bug kind of bit me, so I started saving some mad money, and began looking. The Auto-Trader magazine was popular then, and I cut out and saved every Corvair ad that I found. Most of the ads were in the Atlanta area and north, so it was not easy for me to check them out. But one day luck was with me. I was living in Warner Robins Ga at the time, and one day the local paper had a classified ad for a 1963 Monza coupe, for 650.00. I called about it, and found out that it belonged to a barber in town. When I went to look at it, I found a faded blue car, with tires that were too small. No headliner, and some kind of indoor-outdoor carpet. But the body was straight, and it started and ran (with dual glass-packs, no less). I needed a haircut anyway, so while I got a my hair cut, the deal was made. Three paint jobs and many \$ later, I still have this car. I was my first Corvair, and I don't think I could sell it. A couple of years later, Heart of Georgia Corvairs was formed; the history of which can be found on the club website.

Around 2006 I started looking for a late model convertible. E-Bay had become popular, so that's where I began my search, to get an idea of what kind of money late convertibles were bringing. Found a great looking '68, red with a black top, in Kentucky. The owner sent me lots of pictures, but told me some one had already expressed serious interest in the car, and would let me know if that deal fell through. In the meantime, a '67 came up on E-Bay, just up the road from me in Griffin. Of course I went to see it, and fell immediately in love. Triple black, and only 58,000 miles. Yes, I bought it!

Unfortunately, life gets in the way sometimes, and I let both of my cars sit up without driving them. But, Clay Grant to the rescue!!! He currently has my '67, doing what needs to be done to get it back on the road. I can hardly wait!




