

AUDITION Information for Charlie and the Chocolate Factory

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS:

Auditioners are required to come prepared to sing a one minute audition song. Any song is fine as long as it shows off your voice. You may sing to a CD, (we provide the playing device), you may also sing acapella or bring your own device, (ie, I-Phone, I-Pad, etc.) **NO AUDITION APPOINTMENTS WILL BE TAKEN.** Show up ANYTIME between 5 and 8 p.m. on the date listed on the AUDITION page of our web site. Be sure to bring a parent along so they can list all the conflicts you will have during October, November and December

WHEN ARE THE REHEARSALS?

Rehearsals will be 3 to 4 days a week - week days. 4:00 to 6:30 is the average rehearsal time. The week the show opens rehearsals may go until 8:00 p.m. Rehearsals will be held on the Hearth Theater Stage in the San Marcos Community Center.

TENTATIVE REHEARSAL DATES:

February 28 - 4:30 to 7:00 p.m. / March 1, 2, 7, 14 - 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.

March 8, 9, 15, 16 - 4:30 to 7:30 p.m. / March 18 - 2 to 8 p.m.

March 19, 20, 21 - 4 to 8 p.m. / March 22 - 6 to 9 p.m.

PLAYING DATES:

March 23 - (School show in morning) and 7:30 show

March 24 - 2:00 p.m. show / March 25 - 6:00 p.m. show

Some rehearsal dates and time may change once casting is done and **REMEMBER:** If you have conflicts with any of the rehearsal dates list them on the audition form when you get to the auditions. If you are thinking you have too many conflicts and you **THINK** you shouldn't audition...AUDITION ANYWAY. You may not be called to all the rehearsals you have conflicts for. Let the Director decide. The only way you would **NOT BE CAST**, (DUE TO CONFLICTS), is if you have conflicts with **PLAYING DATES**.

HOW MANY CHILDREN WILL BE CAST and do I need PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE?

No previous experience is necessary. We try our very best to cast every child that auditions. Total cast size can be as high as 50 and as low as 35. We know how hard it is - especially for the beginners - to get up in front of someone and sing. If your child does not get in the show it is because of conflicts with the final schedule; behavioral issues from previous shows; or if your child only wants a specific part and the Director does not seem them in the role they want
