

Crane Machine FAQs

Q: Do I need a special license or what is required in Georgia?

A: Yes. In the state of Georgia you, as a location owner, are required to apply for a CLASS A LOCATION LICENSE. The state currently charges a fee of \$25.00 per CLASS A machine per year. Our licensing period runs from June-June, on a yearly renewal basis. All information may be found on <https://www.gacoam.com> (please type in the address as shown). Q: What information do I need to know to apply for a COAM CLASS A LOCATION license?

A: The application process is very similar to that of a business license or an alcohol license. You will need to have access to specific business particulars such as your STI number, FEIN and other related state information. You will also need personal information on any person associated with the business (i.e. partnerships). The typical information would include SSN, birthdate, address, etc. The entire process is done online at the above mentioned website.

Q: What type of items do you offer?

A: We constantly strive to find compelling items to offer in our crane machines. A few staples are plush animals and candy. We have a revolving rotation of varied plush offerings, balls, toys, etc. If we can legally offer it and it'll work in a crane, we'll try it. However, the state of Georgia limits our prize value on any single item to \$5.00.

Q: I think I'm ready for a crane machine. What do I do next?

A: Please contact us for either an initial site survey or If we have already been on-site, just let us know and we'll get the ball rolling. Once we have reached an agreement, your first step is to secure your COAM CLASS A LOCATION license. We will be happy to assist in any way we can.

Q: I have (1) crane machine installed at my location, but I think I may have room for more. I have already received my COAM CLASS A LOCATION license, what's next?

A: If we determine that additional equipment is warranted, making an addendum to your existing license is an easy process. You will only pay the difference for the additional machines and you do not have to pay again for existing equipment. Please be aware that the license does not carry a pro-rated cost. It's \$25.00 per machine, regardless if you apply in July or in June.
