We are also able to enhance our students' knowledge by offering different opportunities to expand their personal growth in all subject matters. We have the privilege not to teach to state tests. We are able to diversify our subject matters to ensure that all our students excel to their personal best. We are able to offer high school classes to our 8th grade students. This gives them the opportunity to take high school classes while still being in our small nurturing environment.

Teamwork is an important life skill that helps each one of our students achieve their personal best. Parents play an important role in our team along with our certified teachers, Intervention Specialist, Title I teacher, guidance counselor, speech therapist and our aides. We work closely together to help foster academic and spiritual growth for each one of our students.

We offer many scholarship opportunities so that Sacred Heart School can be an affordable choice for any family. One of these is the Jon Peterson Scholarship which is for students who are currently on an IEP. We are also a provider for the EdChoice Expansion Scholarship which is available for families who meet certain income guidelines for incoming Kindergarten, first, second and third grade students. Also offered is the One Faith Many Blessings Scholar- ship available to families that may need tuition assistance to attend our school.

Our community of Faith, Knowledge and Service keeps evolving with the times while keeping a secure belief of our past. We are currently accepting registration for the 20-21 school year for students in preschool – eighth grade. 
The St. Joseph Purse Bingo Committee are planning their event for November 6, 2021.
