Our speaker this week was Lynn Messer who seven years ago, while Kiwanis Governor made "I-Pads for Autism" the districts Signature Project. Lynn had a goal of raising \$500,000 for 1,000 I-Pads to be distributed to children with Autism within this area. So far he has distributed 1,110 I-Pads and has a growing need for more I-Pads. The cost to purchase the I-Pads from Apple range from \$350 -\$450 each. Most of the money raised for the purchase of the I-Pads has come from Kiwanis clubs in the district.

Joe Jacques had also personally contributed for the purchase of additional I-Pads for Autism. That practice was continued by Maria Jacques who presented Lynn with a check for \$1.000 for two more I-Pads for Autism.
