## **Drop-off/Pick-up & Waiting Room Policy**

If you are dropping your child off please make sure you pull over as far to the right as possible so you do not block other cars from entering the parking lot.

Please make sure your child makes it safely to class if you are dropping them off. We ask that you walk all children under the age of eleven into the building. Do not drop students off too early for class as there is no staff supervision in the waiting room. And please make sure to pick your child up on time after class. Please have all students wait in the lobby and not outside to be picked up.

If your child has multiple classes and is under the age of eleven, unless their classes are back-to-back, you must be present with your child in the waiting room during the break.

Also, we ask that any siblings are supervised in the waiting room and that the noise level in the waiting rooms remains at a normal level so as to not be distracting to the classes that are in session.
