## Junior and Adult

### Rules and Regulations

On-line entries will begin August 1<sup>st</sup> and end September 19<sup>th</sup>.

1. Products must have been grown by the exhibitor.
2. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry per class and must furnish jars when applicable.
3. Ribbons and prize money will be awarded through fifth place.
4. Class points will be awarded as follows:

1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th
5	4	3	2	1
5. All exhibitors must receive exhibitor number during check-in.
6. A screening committee shall determine worthiness of products for exhibits. No products will be accepted with artificial coloring, wax, varnished, oil, etc.
7. No entry may be made in "other" when like entry is in another class.
8. All classes will have Junior competition, registered under "Junior Horticulture.". Each plate will be marked to distinguish Junior from Senior entries.
